

## POOL RULES

*The certified lifeguard under the Board is solely responsible for enforcing these Rules and Regulations. Negligence or non-compliance by Residents or Guests will result in loss of Pool privileges.*

- 1) Resident and Guests entering Pool Area must sign the Daily Register. All residents and Guests must present their Pool Passes to the lifeguard.
- 2) No one under the age of 12 is permitted in Pool Area without an adult resident (over 17 yrs. Old) and must leave when the resident leaves.
- 3) Parent/Guardian must watch children closely at all times and must accompany non-swimmers in the water at all times.
- 4) The lifeguard on duty may require any person under the age of 10 years to take a qualifying test before being allowed into the deep end.
- 5) Swimmers must wear proper bathing suits. Cut-offs, shorts or jeans are not allowed in the Pool.
- 6) All infants must wear swim diapers.
- 7) There will be regular rest periods every 45 minutes. All Swimmers **MUST** leave the water and stay out a full 15 minutes.
- 8) The Pool is closed for 30 minutes after each thunder clap or sighting of lightning.
- 9) Accidents and injuries must be reported to the lifeguard immediately.
- 10) A phone is available at the Pool House for use by the lifeguard and 911 Emergencies **ONLY**. No Resident or Guest is permitted to use the Pool phone for outgoing or incoming calls.
- 11) No head first diving is permitted in ANY area of the pool.
- 12) No running, pushing, wild play, shoving, or skateboarding on the Deck Area.
- 13) No tag games are permitted on the Deck Area or combination of the Deck Area and the Pool.
- 14) No playing on ladders or safety rope.
- 15) Rafts are prohibited because they block the lifeguard's view. Noodles and USCG approved life vests are acceptable.
- 16) **NO ALCOHOLIC beverages are permitted in the Pool Area OR the picnic table area.** Anyone obviously under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be denied admission to the Pool Area by the lifeguard.
- 17) Non-Alcoholic drinks and snacks in paper or plastic containers or bags are permitted in the Pool Area. However, all Residents and Guests are required to clean up and dispose of all trash properly. **NO GLASS IN POOL AREA.**
- 18) Any person(s) having contagious or infectious diseases is not permitted to use the Pool.
- 19) No pet allowed in Pool Area. Dogs for the sight-impaired are allowed.
- 20) **ZERO TOLERANCE OF PROFANITY.**
- 21) **NO SMOKING** in the Pool Area. **NO PARKING PERMITTED AT THE POOL.**
- 22) Bicycles are to be parked outside the Pool Area fence, not blocking the entrance gate and at the owner's risk.
- 23) Radios are permitted as long as the volume is **LOW** and not disturbing to others at the Pool.
